School Floater

Description:

Science, Language & Arts is seeking reliable, part-time school floaters to assist lead teachers at our Fort Greene campus. Candidates must be comfortable working with elementary school aged students in PreK through Grade 5 and supervising group activities, arts and crafts, and group games. School floaters may also support our after-school programming.

This is a part-time position with flexible days. Candidates with availability from 9:00am to 6:30pm, or who are available five days a week, are preferred.

This is an excellent opportunity for both current students and recent graduates looking to gain work experience in youth programming and teaching. School experience is helpful but not required.

Responsibilities:

- Providing classroom management for students during park time, lunch time, and after-school. Occasional classroom coverage may be required.
- Guiding children through small group activities and games, set up choice stations, monitor children in free play and nap-time.
- Supporting lead teachers in their classrooms as needed
- Escorting students to field trips, park trips, enrichment classes and to after-care spaces
- Maintaining order in the classroom in a respectful manner
- Managing student rosters and tracking pick-up times

Requirements:

- Must have at least some experience working with children; camp and/or teaching experience a plus
- Ability to communicate clearly in English is required
- Ability to build rapport with students, teachers, and parents

- Ability to speak French or Mandarin strongly preferred but not required
