Our Main Campus, located in the heart of Downtown Brooklyn, New York, serves an international and progressive community of families with students in Pre-K to Grade 5, and hosts external programming for all ages.

SLA is seeking a creative and dynamic French-immersion Assistant Counselor for our 2021 Summer Camp. Our Summer Camp is completely language-immersive and begins in late-June and runs through to early August. Counselors will supervise children in Pre-K to Grade 5, assisting groups in outdoor adventure, STEM exploration, and art throughout the day. This position reports to the Camp Director.

This is an excellent opportunity to foster a unique, learning environment that stimulates children's creative growth and development, as well as to network with a community of progressive, innovative educators. Permission to work in the United States is required.

**NOTE:** Our summer camp enforces strict COVID-19 prevention protocols, including use of face coverings during all camp activities, indoors or outdoors, hand and respiratory hygiene, social distancing from other individuals, and daily health screenings. SLA requires employees to remain home from work for 14 days following instances where an individual is exposed to elevated COVID-19 infection risk. This may be required if exposed to COVID-19 or if conducting restricted travel per the <a href="NYS COVID-19 Travel Advisory">NYS COVID-19 Travel Advisory</a>. Staff must report COVID-19 symptoms to the administrative team immediately, and COVID-19 testing may be required to continue to work on-site.

- Provide daily supervision of Pre-K-5th grade campers
- Guide campers in all camp activities such as science experiments, art projects, outdoor activities, and off-campus adventures
- Support senior counselors to maintain a fun, stimulating, and safe environment for campers
- Facilitate a French-language immersive learning environment, and reinforce the target language for all campers
- Comply with all NY Department of Hygiene and Mental Health (DoHMH) regulations regarding summer camps,

- including completing daily health checks for all campers, maintaining supervisory ratios, completing daily incident reports, etc.
- Complete a two-day counselor orientation prior to the start of camp (may be subject to change depending on social distancing orders in New York City)

- Ability to communicate clearly in English
- Some experience working with children in Pre-K to Grade 5
- Some college experience
- Excellent group management skills
- Highly dynamic personality and hands-on, interactive approach
